Call for Papers

Oral presentations on all the topics of the IGCP 503 project are planned in the afternoon of May 29 in Port-Menier, Anticosti.

All participants of the joint GAC/MAC and IGCP 503 Field Conference are invited to submit short papers. Short papers should be submitted before **February 15, 2008**, while revised manuscripts should be submitted before **April 15, 2008**. Accepted short papers will be published in the field guidebook.

Please read carefully the following guidelines:

- 1) Indicate whether you prefer to give a short talk (20 minutes) or have a poster presentation.
- 2) All manuscripts should be in English and submitted electronically (Word files only).
- 3) The total length of the manuscript (including text-figs, plates, references...) should not exceed 6 printed pages.
- 4) Manuscript should be in the following order: title, author(s)'s name(s), affiliation, postal and email address(es), text, references.
- 5) All references cited in the text are to be listed at the end of the paper following the Canadian Journal of Earth Sciences format.

Whittaker, A.A., Uang, C.-M., and Bertero, V.F. 1990. Experimental seismic response of steel dual systems. In Proceedings of the 4th U.S. National Conference on Earthquake Engineering, Palm Springs, Calif., Vol. 2, pp. 655–664.
- 6) Text-figures and plates: Your final electronic artwork (line drawings, halftones and line/halftone combinations) should be saved or converted into TIFF format with a minimum resolution of 600 dpi. Your TIFF files should be compressed if they are above 2M in size. Each figure or group of figures should be planned to fit, after appropriate reduction, into the area of either one or two columns of text. The maximum finished size of a one-column illustration is 8.6 × 23.7 cm and that of a two-column illustration is 18.2 × 23.7 cm.
